3. SCOPE OF WORK/SERVICE

The scope of works entails the maintenance of the electrical network feeding into buildings owned by MEGA at the identified (industrial) site. The scope of works is broken down as follows:

- 1.1 Provide preventative maintenance services to the electrical network at Ekandustria, and attending to electrical and associated emergencies.
- 1.2 Provide advisory services on all electrical network development needs for the six months period.
- 1.3 Generate monthly reports on the state and performance of the electrical network at the identified site.

5. CAPACITY AND EXPERIENCE IN COORDINATING ELECTRICAL MAINTENANCE PROJECTS OF SIMILAR IN SCOPE

- b) Proof of academic qualifications in the form of certified copies must be attached to the Team Leader/Engineer's CV. Foreign qualifications must be accompanied by a certificate from the Qualifications Certification Body.
- c) The proposed Team Leader shall be in possession of at least a Bachelor's/BTech Degree in Electrical Engineering from any South African University or equivalent qualifications from a recognized Foreign University or Institution.
- d) Proof of professional Registration with Engineering Council of South Africa (ECSA) in the form of certified copies must be attached to the Team Leader/Engineer's CV. The proposed Team Leader shall be registered as Professional Engineering Technologist (Pr. Tech. Eng) or Professional Engineer (Pr. Eng).
- e) A minimum of 10 years' post qualification experience is required for the team leader.
- f) All electricians should have at least 5 years' post qualification work experience. CVs and copies of qualifications are to be included. The minimum requirements for qualifications as an electrician are a (3) year Electrical Engineering Diploma (i.e. NQF N1-N3), possession of a wireman license and registration Department of Labour (DoL) as an electrician.
- g) Proof that bidders have worked on at least one project of a similar size as Ekundustria Industrial Park where they have been responsible for undertaking period inspections of the entire electricity supply network, and carrying out scheduled and emergency maintenance and repairs for a continuous period of six (6) months.

This preference form must form part of all tenders invited. It contains general information and serves as a claim form for preference points for specific goals.

- 1.5 Failure on the part of a tenderer to submit proof or documentation required in terms of this tender to claim points for specific goals with the tender, will be interpreted to mean that preference points for specific goals are not claimed.
- 1.6 The organ of state reserves the right to require of a tenderer, either before a tender is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the organ of state.

2. DEFINITIONS

- (a) **“tender”** means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation to provide goods or services through price quotations, competitive tendering process or any other method envisaged in legislation;
- (b) **“price”** means an amount of money tendered for goods or services, and includes all applicable taxes less all unconditional discounts;
- (c) **“rand value”** means the total estimated value of a contract in Rand, calculated at the time of bid invitation, and includes all applicable taxes;
- (d) **“tender for income-generating contracts”** means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation for the origination of income-generating contracts through any method envisaged in legislation that will result in a legal agreement between the organ of state and a third party that produces revenue for the organ of state, and includes, but is not limited to, leasing and disposal of assets and concession contracts, excluding direct sales and disposal of assets through public auctions; and
- (e) **“the Act”** means the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000 (Act No. 5 of 2000).

4. POINTS AWARDED FOR SPECIFIC GOALS

- 4.1. In terms of Regulation 4(2); 5(2); 6(2) and 7(2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, preference points must be awarded for specific goals stated in the tender. For the purposes of this tender the tenderer will be allocated points based on the goals stated in table 1 below as may be supported by proof/ documentation stated in the conditions of this tender:
- 4.2. In cases where organs of state intend to use Regulation 3(2) of the Regulations, which states that, if it is unclear whether the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system applies, an organ of state must, in the tender documents, stipulate in the case of—
