1. PROJECT PURPOSE

The purpose of this Request for Quotation (RFQ) invites suitably qualified and experienced service providers to submit quotations for the refurbishment work at Plot 52 Cottage, White River.

The appointed service provider will be responsible for delivering high-quality work in accordance with the project specifications, applicable standards, and the required timelines.

2. SERVICE PROVIDER'S TERMS OF REFERENCE

The Mpumalanga Economic Growth Agency (MEGA) seeks to engage the services of a suitably qualified and experienced service provider for the **refurbishment**, **repair and installation works** at **Plot 52 Cottage 4**, **White River**. The scope of work involves general building maintenance, internal finishes, roofing, plumbing, electrical works, fumigation, and joinery installations to improve the overall condition and usability of the facility.

A formal **Service Level Agreement (SLA)** will be entered into with the appointed service provider, outlining the full scope of work, deliverables, timelines, and contractual obligations related to the project.

These **Terms of Reference (ToR)** serve as a framework for the evaluation and appointment process, ensuring alignment between MEGA's project requirements and the technical capabilities, compliance, and qualifications of the service provider. The successful bidder's proposal will form the basis of the SLA to be concluded with MEGA.

3. PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS

GENERAL SCOPE OF WORK

The Service provider must be CIDB GRADE 1 GB accredited or Higher, attach supporting documentation

The scope of work includes but is not limited to:

a. Painting and Surface Finishes

- Painting internal walls, ceilings, and doors with two coats of paint.
- Application of waterproof-based paint on roof sheets and steel trusses.
- Supply and installation of hardwood skirting.
- Repair of floor cracks.

b. Tiling

- Floor and wall tile removal and replacement with matching ceramic tiles.
- Supply and installation of new cement floor tiles.

c. Carpentry and Joinery

- Supply and installation of interior and exterior timber doors.
- Installation of PVC folding closet door.
- Installation of kitchen and bedroom built-in cupboards (BICs).
- Installation of white floor-standing bathroom cabinet with drop-in basin.
- Brickwork construction.
- Supply and installation of brass window handles and stays.

d. Electrical Installation

- Installation of ceiling lights, LED spotlights, light switches, and plug points.
- Electrical cabling and connections.
- Supply and installation of complete downlights and wiring where needed.

e. Plumbing and Sanitary Ware

- Installation of:
 - Toilet seat cover
 - Close-coupled cistern (Bibo)
 - Chrome-plated showerhead (160 mm)
 - o Kitchen sink with hot and cold taps
- · Repair and replacement of leaking pipes and fixtures.
- Refurbish any affected brickwork and plastering after plumbing work.

f. Roofing

• Repair roof leaks, apply waterproof coating, and install ridge capping.

g. Gutters and Downpipes

- Supply and installation of:
 - o galvanised downpipes and brackets
 - o galvanised gutters and brackets

h. Fumigation

- Complete fumigation treatment for all internal spaces including roof and ceiling voids, using approved chemicals to eliminate pests.
- Provide a valid fumigation certificate.

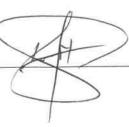
